ALLEGATIONS COMMON TO ALL COUNTS

Nature of the Case

1. Plaintiff uses and is the owner of a federal registered trademark used in connection with various products (“Arctic Monkeys Mark”). A true and correct copy of the registration certificate for Plaintiff’s Trademark is attached as **Exhibit A**.
2. This action has been filed by Plaintiff to combat e-commerce store operators who trade upon Plaintiff’s reputation and goodwill by selling and/or offering for sale products using infringing and counterfeit versions of Plaintiff’s federally registered Arctic Monkeys Mark (“Unauthorized Arctic Monkeys Products”).
